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INTRODUCTION

1. Scope

Designed for the implementation of bachelors training by educational program (hereinafter - EP) code "6B02310 Philology: Kazakh language" in RSE on right of economic management "M.Auezov South Kazakhstan State University" of RK MES.

The educational program establishes requirements for the preparation of philologists with fundamental linguistic and literary knowledge, for use in research organizations, cultural organizations, the media, editorial and publishing activities, public and private services.

3. Educational programs concept

Fundamental theoretical and methodological training of graduate students of philologists ensures their professional competence. New philological trends arise as a response to the demands of the life of society, and hence the life of the language. Currently, there is an urgent need for highly qualified personnel with knowledge of several foreign languages, proficient in the methods of effective communication between representatives of different cultures, capable of translating oral and written texts of various styles and genres, organizing linguistic support for international conferences, symposia, forums using several working languages.

The educational program is aimed at achieving learning outcomes through the organization of the educational process using the principles of the Bologna process of student-centered learning. The educational program represents the field of linguistics, which considers language as a means of understanding the world, forming and expressing thoughts, storing and organizing knowledge. The subject of study in this area is ways of implementing interlingual communication, intercultural communication, linguistic support of professional contacts.

A philologist engaged in research should be able to assess linguistic facts and phenomena from the point of view of modern general scientific and linguistic achievements, including methodological ones. One of the constant problems in the field of linguistics is the improvement of the methods of linguistic research. It can be especially difficult for novice researchers to understand the methodology of science due to the abundance of terms, the variety of their interpretations, modifications and classification principles.

The learning outcomes of the program are achieved through the following training activities:

- classroom lessons: lectures, seminars, practical exercises are conducted taking into account innovative teaching technologies, the use of the latest achievements of science, technology and information systems;
- outside the classroom: independent work of the student, including under the guidance of a teacher, individual consultations;
- Conducting professional practices, performing master's work (projects).

Scientific research is a form of existence and development of science. The process of scientific cognition is particularly systematic and consistent. Scientific search always has an organized and purposeful nature of a specific research. Therefore, scientific research, as one of the types of human cognitive activity, is impossible without the ability to apply various methods of cognition. Practical development of the methodology of science allows you to effectively search for new knowledge, to reasonably choose methods in the study of a new scientific problem. Today, hundreds of thousands of people around the world are involved in research and development. The results of their research become a direct productive force, to a large extent determine the directions and trends in the development of modern society. New forms of organization of science are being formed, large research teams are being formed, in which scientists are faced with the need to systematize the methods used, to develop interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary research strategies. The general definition of science can sound as follows: science is a certain human activity, which is highlighted in the process of division of labor and is aimed at obtaining knowledge, that is, science is the production of knowledge. Modern science includes various aspects such as:

- 1) the means and devices necessary for the study of phenomena;
- 2) methods for studying phenomena;
- 3) institutes, scientific organizations;
- 4) people engaged in scientific research;
- 5) a system of knowledge, recorded in the form of texts;
- 6) conferences, scientific expeditions, the defense of diplomas, dissertations, etc. All of the above aspects of scientific research in the chosen direction of training must be mastered by the undergraduate.
- research work of a master's student, including conducting an independent scientific research, foreign scientific internship at a university of a foreign scientific consultant, preparing scientific publications and performing a master's thesis; planning of research work of undergraduates is carried out by semester in accordance with the working curricula of educational programs; at the end of each semester, undergraduates, during the intermediate attestation of research and development work, submit a report on the results of the research work carried out at a meeting of the graduating department in the presence of scientific consultants.
