The current situation in the Kazakhstani market of educational services is characterized by increased competition. At the same time, the key factor in the competitiveness of educational organizations is the quality of the educational services provided, established through various quality assessment mechanisms. One of the priority areas is the training of competitively capable personnel on the basis of the continuous development of the intellectual and spiritual potential of the individual. The sphere of foreign language education is no exception, in connection with this, the 6B02330-Foreign Philology module study program for the preparation of foreign philologists is necessary, and its content is relevant.

The aim of the study program is consistent with the mission of the university, as well as the requests of employers and students.

The study program corresponds to the National qualification framework of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Learning outcomes based on Dublin descriptors embedded in professional standards are expressed through competencies. At the same time, 12 main learning outcomes stand out.
