

<p><b>Requirements for applicants</b></p>	<p>For students with SEN (special educational needs) and persons with disabilities (PSI), tactile PVC tiles, specially equipped toilets, a mnemonic diagram, and shower bars have been installed in educational buildings and student dormitories. Special parking spaces have been created. Crawler lift installed. There are desks for people with limited mobility (PLM), signs indicating the direction of movement, ramps. In the educational buildings (main building, building No. 8) there are 2 rooms with six working places adapted for users with disorders of the musculoskeletal system (DMS). For visually impaired users, the SARA™ CE Machine (2 pcs.) is available for scanning and reading books. The library website is adapted for the visually impaired. There is a special NVDA audio program with a service.
