

1. The text of the article is provided on paper and in electronic form. The text should be typed in Microsoft Word text editor, Times New Roman font, font size of the main text - 12 p.t., figures, diagrams - 11 p.t., line spacing - single, indentation at the beginning of the paragraph - 1.0, width alignment.

2. Page parameters: A4 format, margins: left - 2 cm, right - 2 cm, top - 2 cm, bottom – 2 cm.

3. The total volume of the article, including tables, illustrations and a list of references, is from 4 to 10 pages.

4. The title of the article should be brief and reflect its content (in three languages).

5. For an article in Kazakh, an abstract and an abstract, for an article in Russian, a tuyin and an abstract, for an article in English, a tuyin and an abstract are required. The contents of the abstract, tuin, and abstract should be identical. The number of words is 100-150.

6. Information about the author(s) should include: Full name, academic degree, academic title, institution name, city, country, e-mail (in three languages).

7. The publication of incorrectly designed articles is delayed. Article structure The structure of a scientific article should include the following elements:

1. UDC (universal decimal classification index) - in the upper-left corner (11 p.m.). You can use the website to assign a UDC to an article. <http://teacode.com/online/udc/>

2. Full name of the author(s) in the center, distributed by width (12 p.t.) Position, academic degree and academic title, name of the organization, city, country (in three languages) (11 p.t.). Information about the authors is written in the center, initials and the surname of the author(s) of the article (first the initials, then the surname – L.A. Myrzaev), the font is bold. The author can publish no more than two articles in one issue of the journal, including co-authorship. The number of authors should not exceed 5 people.

3. \* The author for correspondence: \* specify the author for correspondence, the mail of one of the authors, 11 p.m.

4. The title of the article (title) is separated by a line, highlighted in bold, centered. It should accurately reflect the content, be concise and concise. Abbreviations of words in the title are not allowed- Caps Lock 12 p.t.

5. Abstract - in the language of the article, indentation 1 cm, 11 p.t. In one line, an abstract of 100-150 words. Russian Russian and English for an article published in Kazakh; Kazakh and English for an article published in Russian; Kazakh and Russian for an article published in English). The structure of the abstract includes the following MANDATORY points:

- the purpose of the study,
- Research methodology,
- the originality (value) of the research
- Research results

An abstract (author's summary) is a short summary of a scientific paper. According to the abstract, the reader should understand the essence of the research. The results of the work are described very accurately and informatively. The text should not contain secondary information, unnecessary introductory words, general and insignificant formulations, abbreviations, references to literature. The abstract is written in one paragraph. A well-designed and translated abstract increases interest in the article, as well as the likelihood of the article being cited by foreign colleagues.

6. Keywords – from 5 to 7 words, 11 p.t. Keywords are designed to search for an article and determine its subject area, with an indentation of 1 cm, the number is from 5 to 7 words.

Avoid participial/adverbial phrases and complex constructions that are not natural search queries. Keywords should be relevant, natural and not overload the text, so as not to look like spam.

7. The text part of the article (12 p.m.). The article should be structured using headings, the headings are not numbered, for example:

### **Introduction**

Relevance of the work, literature review, main provisions of the study

### **Materials and methods**

- Theoretical analysis

- The experimental part

Drawings, maps, photographs, tables, and formulas are recommended to be performed using computer technology and posted in the article as they are mentioned. The ordinal numbers of the figures are indicated by Arabic numerals, the name of the figure is given in the center below the figure (Figure 1 is the name of the figure). The tables are reflected in the text of the article after the first link or on the next page. The number and name of the table are given on the left side of the page (Table 1 is the name of the table). If the table is moved to the next page, the columns are numbered and the continuation of the table is indicated on the right side of the next page (Continuation of Table 1). Formulas must be typed in one of the formula editors (Microsoft Equation or MathType). Tables and figures should be placed after the mention. Each table must have a name. The drawings should be clear, not scanned. Sample caption: Fig. 1. Dependence ....: a - ...; b - ... All abbreviations and abbreviations, with the exception of known ones, should be deciphered at the first mention in the text.

Conclusion, research results and discussion, practical suggestions and recommendations.

- **Information about financing (if available).**

#### **Gratitude**

If available, specify in one paragraph the sources of research funding, organizations, persons who provided assistance, etc.

#### **References**

One line apart, in the center. The list of references should include only those works that are cited in the text and that have been published or accepted for publication. Literary sources should be numbered in the order in which they are mentioned in the text. Literary sources that are no more than 10-15 years old should make up at least 70% of the list. There should be at least 7 sources of literature. References to sources of literature should be indicated in [] square brackets in the text of the article and without specifying the pages. ([1], [2]...).

Russian Russian translation If the article is presented in Kazakh or Russian, it is mandatory to provide a transliterated list of references (to use the website for transliterating sources in Russian). <http://translit-online.ru> , in Kazakh <https://qazlat.kz>

At the end of the article, the full surname, first name, patronymic (if any), academic degree are given.,

title, place of work of the author(s); name of the university (organization), city, country; contact information (e-mail) for each author; title (title) articles; abstract; keywords in two languages, distinguishable from the language of the article (Kazakh/Russian, English). The editorial board of the journal independently sends the submitted work for review. The journal uses double-blind review, i.e. confidential. The editorial board checks the article for borrowings (licensed software is used). The originality of the text must be at least 70%. An article that does not achieve the required percentage of originality is sent to the author for revision.

#### **Preparation of articles**

1. The article has not been previously published, nor has it been submitted for review and publication in another journal.

2. An author may publish no more than two articles in one issue of the journal, including co-authorship (otherwise decided by the editorial board of the journal).

3. The number of authors should not exceed 5 people. When submitting an article to the editorial board, please read the requirements and examples developed by the editors for the authors.:
