05.11.2025г.	<p>1 The Security and Order Service shall regularly organize preventive measures to ensure safety in the campuses and prevent property theft, including the effective use of 24-hour video surveillance systems, strengthening security measures, and maintaining silence during nighttime hours. (Implementation period: throughout the academic year)</p>	B.Ashimov	<p>During October–November 2025, additional surveillance cameras were installed in the student residences, the locks on emergency exit doors were replaced, and the keys were placed under the personal supervision of security personnel. In accordance with established procedures, all items brought into and taken out of the residence halls are registered in entry and exit logbooks. Furthermore, in order to prevent and suppress offenses among students residing in the university residences, meetings were organized with representatives of the Department for Combating Organized Crime, the Anti-Drug Crime Department of the Shymkent City Police Department, officers of the Turan, Al-Farabi, and Abay District Police Departments, as well as representatives of the Juvenile Affairs Division. These meetings were conducted with the participation of Vice-Rector G. Besbaev and the heads of the Department for Discipline Enforcement.</p>

Due to the insufficient number of computers in the student residences and their unsatisfactory technical condition, the Department of Digitalization shall develop a plan for upgrading the material and technical infrastructure, providing the residence halls with new computer equipment, and taking measures to ensure the stable operation of the Internet network. (Implementation deadline: January 20, 2026)</p>	<p>M.Uatbaev</p>	<p>In the 2025–2026 academic year, the procurement of 500 computers is planned through the public procurement portal. Furthermore, the allocation of a portion of the newly acquired computers to the student residences is under consideration.</p> <p>At present, the Internet network in the residence halls operates continuously and reliably.</p> <p>Copy of the plan relevant section.</p>

The Department for Educational Work and Youth Policy shall discuss the results of the survey entitled “<i>Students’ Evaluation of Living Conditions in the campuses of SKU</i>” and consider measures aimed at eliminating deficiencies in private student housing facilities. (Implementation deadline: December 20, 2025)</p>	<p>Sh.M. Zulpanov</p>	<p>According to the survey results, all students indicated the existing issues related to their living conditions in the questionnaire. It was also established that some furniture items and door locks in the student housing facilities had become unusable. This information was reported to the residence administration, after which the necessary repair work was carried out. In addition, it was revealed that students had no complaints regarding the operation of the dining facilities in the student residences.</p> <p>The Director of the Department for Educational Work and Youth Policy, Sh. Zulpanov, reminded students of the importance of complying with the internal regulations of the student</p>	

			<p>housing facilities, including the prohibition on entering or leaving the premises after 11:00 p.m. Remarks were also made regarding compliance with cleanliness and sanitary requirements.</p> <p>The officer responsible for safety provided information on compliance with fire safety regulations, the proper use of electrical appliances, and procedures to be followed in emergency situations. It was additionally emphasized that students are prohibited from engaging in delivery-related activities involving mopeds, scooters, and similar vehicles.</p>
